



Engine Cover Insert Installation Instruction Sheet

Please Read Carefully

Our Engine Cover Insert is designed to fit on the stock engine cover. If you have altered this area in any way then it is your responsibility to do a test fitment to confirm it will fit.

Every model and year will have some little differences therefore we **strongly recommend that prior to prep and paint you install your Engine Cover Insert cover and do a test fitment first.**

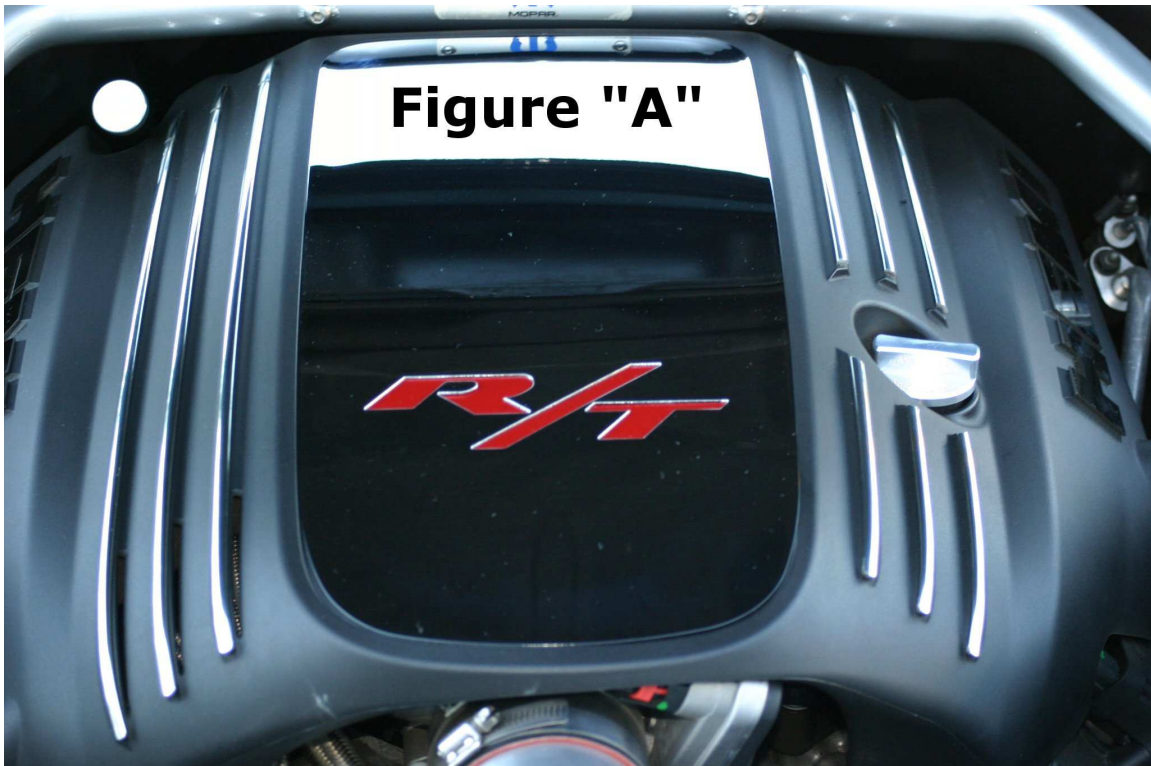
Make sure it fits correctly and there no interferences.

Note: If you have ordered your Engine Cover Insert with a cut-out and are planning on using the 3G provided metal backer plate then please refer to the "3G Backer Plates Installation Instruction Sheet" in our download center for it's proper installation.

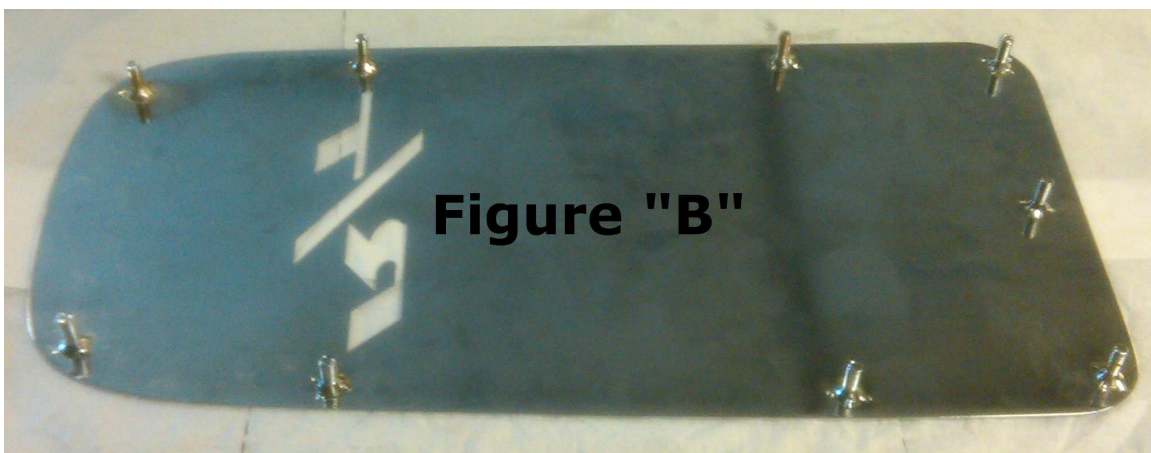
Installing the Cover

Remove your stock engine cover insert.

Next set in place your new Engine Cover Insert as shown in Figure "A".



There are (9) nuts on the underside that hold it into place as shown in Figure "B". Use the provided washers and nuts to secure the insert in place. Tighten snug but do not over tighten.



If all looks well and you are happy with the fit and position then you are ready to remove the insert and apply its final finish and then re-install.

- (1) 3GCUSTOMZ Engine Cover Insert
- (9) 1/4" Washers
- (9) 1/4" Nuts
- (1) Instruction/installation sheet

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
